Conference on quantum optics Obergurgl, Austria, from 24 February to 1 March 	<p></p> <p></p> <p>FP7 in Brief</p> <p>The Seventh Framework Programme (FP7) refers to the next programme in a series of multi-annual Framework Programmes that have been the European Union's main instrument for funding R&D since 1984. Programmes have so far been conceived for a period of five years. FP7, however, is proposed for the period 2007-2013. The total European Commission (EC) budget of FP7 is € 53.2 billion. The broad objectives of FP7 have been grouped into four specific programmes: <i>Cooperation, Ideas, People and Capacities</i>. For each type of broad objectives, there is a specific programme corresponding to the main areas of EU research policy. On 4 June 2007, the Commission adopted a decision on the use of lump sum payments for International Cooperation Partner Countries (ICPC). This sum covers all the costs of an ICPC participant including the costs for personnel and travel, equipment, consumables and indirect costs. • National events related to FP7

The Higher Council for Science and Technology (HCST) -Jordan's Information Point organized a joint seminar during 8-10/1/2008 for the four projects namely: Idealist7fp, ERA-MED, FOOD-N-CO and PROMEDAccess.

6 European experts from France, Greece, Belgium, Italy and Austria carried out the presentations as follows:

The first day (8/1/2008): General presentations on FP7, ERA-MED, and PROMEDAccess projects.

The second day (9/1/2008): Three parallel sessions on health, Information and Communication Technologies (ICT), and food, agriculture, fisheries, and biotechnology (FAFB).

The first day and the parallel sessions took place at the Holiday Inn Hotel while PROMEDAccess practical training for the liaison officers took place at the University of Jordan during 9-10/1/2008. The objective of such training is to enable these officers to act as our representatives in different Research, Academic, and SMEs institutions in our endeavor to disseminate information about FP7 and other EC RTD sponsored activities.

• Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Q1: What scope is there for R&D players from non-EU countries to participate in FP7?

A: The International Cooperation Partner Countries (ICPCs), including those of the Mediterranean region, can participate in all four specific programmes of FP7 - Cooperation, Capacities, People, Ideas – so long as they respect the minimum consortium composition requirements (unless otherwise specified in the call text).

Cooperation programme

ICPCs can participate in the following ways:

- in the regular calls for proposals for the above themes
- in the Specific International Cooperation Actions (SICA), which are calls for proposals dedicated to ICPCs on each of the above themes.

Capacities programme

All the elements of the Capacities Programme are open to third country participation but particularly the actions of International Cooperation, which support Bilateral & Bi-regional coordination of S&T cooperation as well as the coordination of national policies on S&T among EU and ICPC countries.

People programme

This is the mobility arm of FP7. ICPCs can participate through:

- International incoming/outgoing fellowships
- International reintegration grants
- An international cooperation scheme to support common initiatives between EU organisations and countries with S&T agreements
- Measures to counter the risk of 'brain drain' from ICPCs through support for 'scientific diasporas'.

Ideas programme

ICPCs can participate in the Ideas Programme. However, their participation would need to be justified on the basis of the scientific value they would add to the consortium.
